Who's the program for?

Any U.S. based registered nonprofits (501(c)(3) public charities) providing legal advice, assistance, and representation to individuals in their local communities is eligible for this program. The discounts will be most useful to those which operate in the states where we're a certified eFiling service.

How the program works

1. eFiling & eService: No One Legal fees

Completely free use of our eFiling and eService platform. We're a certified eFiling service in California, Illinois, Indiana, and Texas.

2. 20% discount on physical services

Discounted use of physical services, including nationwide professional process serving and court research and retrieval.

3. Simple billing and statements

Where necessary, we pay all court fees upfront on your behalf. Access clear and simple statements that are easy to reconcile to cases.

4. Tailored training & support

We'll provide you with all the help you need to get set up. You'll get a dedicated account manager and access to all of our support.
